### **NOMINATIONS**

Notice is hereby given that a date of Saturday 21 April 2018 has been fixed for the election of eight (8) Trustees to the Kahukuraariki Trust.

### **NOMINATIONS RECEIVED**

Nominations for the eight (8) Trustees to the Kahukuraariki Trust closed at 5pm, Wednesday 14 February 2018. The following people have been duly nominated:

As there are more candidates than there are vacancies to be filled for Otangaroa Marae, an election will be held between the listed candidates on Saturday 21 April 2018 under the First Past the Post electoral system by postal and online voting, or in person at the Wahi Pooti.

Voting closes at 12 noon on Saturday 21 April 2018. Completed voting papers will be accepted up to Tuesday 24 April 2018, provided that the envelope is postmarked on or before Saturday 21 April 2018.
